



◆ TRAIL DETAILS ◆

In German, Kolonieweg translates to "Colony Way" which perfectly describes this trail that connects the villages of Amana and Middle Amana. In the future, Kolonieweg trail will link up all seven villages. In the meantime, you'll find exhibits, activities, and history while you explore.

LENGTH: 5 miles

Depot/Lily Lake Loop – 3.1 miles

ACTIVITIES: Biking & walking

Winter - cross country skiing & snowshoeing

DIFFICULTY/SKILL LEVEL: Easy

TRAIL SURFACES: Mixed

Asphalt or concrete with a short section of crushed stone on the levee between Lily Lake and Millrace.

HOURS: Sunrise to sunset

Open year-round

PUBLIC RESTROOMS: Off-site

Located at the Amana Colonies Convention & Visitors Center.

TRAIL ENTRANCE & PARKING:

- **Amana Depot Trailhead**
One block south of Hotel Millwright & Millstream Brewery. Seasonal restrooms also available.
- **Lily Lake Picnic Area**
On the "north shore" along Highway 220 between Amana & Middle Amana.
- **Clear Creek Elementary**
Elementary school's east parking lot. (primarily used for overflow parking)

◆ LAKE WILDLIFE ◆

The Lily Lake, which blooms from July to August with yellow lotus lily flowers, offers trail goers many opportunities to spot a large variety of birds and wildlife. Eagles and Pelicans are common in the spring and Canadian Geese and Trumpeter Swans are often sited year-round.

East Amana and the Amana Colonies Golf Course are also accessible via a marked bike route.
